Front Passenger's Seat Base Cover Is Loose

SYMPTOM

The recline cover on the base of the front passenger's seat is loose.

PROBABLE CAUSE

The clip on the cover is not strong enough to hold it in place.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Replace the clip with an improved part, or replace both the cover and the clip if the cover is damaged.

PARTS INFORMATION

Clip (black): P/N 90661-SDB-A71,

(Use if cover is not damaged.) H/C 7822349

P/N81238-SCV-L01ZA, Recline Cover (right side):

(Use only if old cover is H/C 8399396

damaged during removal.)



Out of warranty: Any repair performed after warranty expiration may be eligible for goodwill consideration by the District Parts and Service Manager or your Zone Office. You must request consideration, and get a decision, before starting work.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- Remove the recline cover:
 - Refer to page 20-108 of the 2007–2008 Element Service Manual, or
 - Online, enter keywords FRONT SEAT, and select Front Seat Cushion Cover Replacement from the list.



- 2. Inspect the cover for damage:
 - If the cover is not damaged, replace the silver trim clip with a new black clip, and reinstall the cover (do not replace it).
 - If the cover is damaged, replace it (it already has the new clip attached).
